Dear Senator Warren:

Thank you for your letter, jointly signed by Ranking Members Gary Peters, Committee on Homeland Security & Governmental Affairs and Patty Murray, Committee on Health, Education, Labor & Pensions requesting that the Government Accountability Office review whether the CDC and FDA's scientific integrity and communications policies have been violated and whether those policies are being implemented as intended to assure scientific integrity throughout the agency.

GAO accepts your request as work that is within the scope of its authority. Consistent with GAO Congressional Protocols, given broad congressional interest in these issues, and as agreed by your staff, we will allow co-requesters of this work and we will be including the appropriate committees named in Section 19010 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, Public Law 116-136 as addressees.

Your request has been assigned to Ms. A. Nicole Clowers, Managing Director, Health Care. At the current time we anticipate that staff with the required skills will be available to initiate an engagement in about three months. Closer to the time GAO can start this engagement, Ms. Clowers or a member of her team will contact Laura Aguilar to confirm that this request continues to be your priority for us. As applicable, we will also be in contact with the cognizant Inspector General's office to ensure that we are not duplicating efforts. If an issue arises during this coordination, we will consult with you regarding its resolution.
