5	(1) none of the funds appropriated or otherwise
6	made available to the Department of Homeland Se-

9	2018 and Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster
10	Relief Requirements Act, 2017 (Public Law 115–
11	56), the Additional Supplemental Appropriations for

13	115–72), the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018 (Public
14	Law 115–123), or the FAA Reauthorization Act of

18	physical barrier along the southwest border of the

20	(2) none of the funds appropriated or otherwise
21	made available to the Corps of Engineers under the
22	Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018 (Public Law 115–
23	123) may be transferred or reprogrammed under
24	section 923 of the Water Resources Development
25	Act of 1986 (33 U.S.C. 2293).
