## **Dear Senators:**

Thank you for your letter of March 27, 2025. We write to inform you that the U.S. Department of Education (Department) Office of Inspector General (OIG) will be initiating a series of reviews to provide information on the Department's programs and operations following recent workforce changes. These workforce changes will include employee separations via the Deferred Resignation Program, Voluntary Separation Incentive Payment and Voluntary Early Retirement incentives, and reduction in force actions. These reviews are consistent with our statutory responsibility to conduct audits and investigations relating to the Department's programs and operations, and to promote economy, efficiency and effectiveness in such programs and operations. We recently shared this information with Secretary McMahon, as well as the Chairs and Ranking Members of our authorizing, appropriating, and oversight committees, consistent with our dual reporting responsibilities.

We will be conducting reviews of selected departmental offices in order to identify the cumulative effect of staffing reductions in relation to the selected offices' programs and responsibilities, along with any actions that the Department should consider to help ensure productive and efficient operations following its workforce changes.

We hope to begin issuing these reports in the summer of 2025, and we may identify additional work to be performed based on the results of our initial reviews.
