Dear Senator Warren, Senator Blumenthal and Representative Stansbury,

Thank you for your March 9, 2026, letter. X Corp. takes all inquiries from members of Congress seriously and appreciates the opportunity to respond.

As has been publicly reported, X Corp. entered into a \$10 million group settlement with several individual and institutional plaintiffs, specifically the American Conservative Union, Rafael Barbosa, Linda Cuadros, Dominick Latella, Wayne Allyn Root, Donald Trump, and Naomi Wolf, to resolve their collective legal claims based on Twitter's censorship of their social media accounts prior to Elon Musk's acquisition of the company.<sup>1</sup>

With respect to your questions regarding the terms of that agreement, as you note in your letter, the settlement has not been made public.<sup>2</sup> X Corp. is bound by the confidentiality terms of that agreement.

X Corp. remains committed to operating responsibly and in accordance with all legal requirements. We value constructive engagement with Congress. Please do not hesitate to contact us if we can be of further assistance.
