Westover Air Reserve Base	Requesting \$35,000,000 to support necessary construction of a concrete taxiway surface at Westover ARB for eight permanently assigned C-5M and transient aircraft scheduled for ISO maintenance at Westover in support of global airlift missions. Proper upgrades are needed to avoid any negative impacts.	Chicopee MA	\$35,000
U.S. Army Natick Soldier Systems Center	Project funds will be used to construct a Human Engineering Laboratory (DoD Combat Feeding) at the Natick Soldier Systems Center (NSSC). The Engineering Program is responsible for field feeding needs of the joint force in all current and future environments in which they operate.	Natick MA	\$8,000
U.S. Army Natick Soldier Systems Center	Provide \$7.5 million in Military Construction, Army planning and design funds to complete design of a new Human Engineering Laboratory at Natick Soldier Systems Center, DoD's only combat feeding research facility, serving all military branches and NASA. The project replaces 1950s-era labs.	Natick MA	\$7,500
Barnes Air National Guard Base	Installation is scheduled to receive F-35 aircraft and new F-35 flight simulators. A facility housing aircraft flight simulators and other training devices is required to maintain operational readiness, as well as an adequately sized and configured facility to train and maintain combat proficiency.	Westfield MA	\$39,346
